Program Commitment	One year of clinical service at an approved site for each year of loan repayment	One year of clinical service at an approved site for each year of loan repayment
Minimum Participation Commitment	2 years	3 years
Maximum Participation Commitment	Up to two additional years as long as program funds are available	Up to two 3 year continuations as long as program funds are available
Minimum Clinical Practice	Full & part-time options available	Full & part-time options available
Eligible Practice Site Must Be	Nonprofit, offer discount to patients below 200% FPL, no patient asset testing, HPSA, and approved by ORH	Serving Medicaid and/or Medicare patients, HPSA, and approved by ORH
Eligible Practice Type	Outpatient primary care	Outpatient primary care
Patient Criteria	Must see all patients regardless of ability to pay	Must see Medicaid and/or Medicare patients
Maximum	\$35,000 per obligation year, with a lifetime max of \$100,000	\$35,000 per obligation year
Site Contribution	50% of award + 10% admin fee on total award amount	None
Funding Source	Federal grant + site match	State of Oregon
Tax Liability	Award is tax free	Award is tax free

Providers may apply for more than one Loan Repayment Program at a time. If offered an award by more than one program, only one award may be accepted. Examples of Loan Repayment programs include, but are not limited to: Oregon Partnership State Loan Repayment Program (SLRP); National Health Service Corps (NHSC); Healthcare Provider Incentive Loan Repayment; NURSE Corps, NHSC Scholars; and/or other State, Federal, or local Loan programs offering funds in exchange for a service obligation.

Eligible Students Must Be	Enrolled at an approved school in an ORH approved rural training track	Admitted to OHSU in an approved discipline
Program Commitment	During education: Remain enrolled full time in good academic standing. Upon graduation or completion of residency: One year of clinical service at an approved site for each year of loan forgiveness	During education: Remain enrolled full time in good academic standing. Upon graduation or completion of residency: One year of clinical service at an approved site for each year of loan forgiveness, plus one additional year
Minimum Participation Commitment	1 year	3 years for NP, PA, & CRNA 5 years for MD & DMD
Maximum Participation Commitment	1 year for PA & NP 3 years for DO & MD	3 years for NP, PA, & CRNA 5 years for MD & DMD
Minimum Clinical Practice	Full-time only	Full-time only
